OUTDOOR SCHOOL

What is Outdoor School? Every year our 5th graders head out to Outdoor School Camp for a three–night/ four–day science extravaganza at the Oregon Coast run by Northwest Outdoor Science School.

Where is it? For the last several years, Edgewood has done Outdoor School at Camp Westwind located just a few miles north of Lincoln City.

Why Camp Westwind? With its 508 acres of wild coastal land, camp Westwind is an ideal place to study natural science and explore its wildlife.

What is the focus of Outdoor School? Much of our 5th grade science curriculum occurs at Outdoor School. Northwest Outdoor Science School provides hands on science learning experiences. Students are exposed to careers in science and natural resource management and they participate in real scientific research through data collection and analysis.

What are the facilities? Facilities include a lodge with dining hall, modern shower house and restrooms, fifteen cabins, learning center, staff and teacher lodging and health center.

How much does it cost? The cost is around \$250 per student. This cost includes meals and transportation. In order to reduce the amount, we apply for grants, conduct fundraisers and receive support from our PTA. Our goal is to lower the individual cost to \$60 the year that the kids attend Outdoor School.

Why is there an Outdoor School fee for lower grades? Every year we ask each family to pay \$25-\$30 towards their student's grade's Outdoor School fund. This acts like a savings account for the class to help cover the costs of their Outdoor School expenses when they become 5th graders. Please note that every student will attend Outdoor School, regardless of a family's ability to pay. Scholarships are available.
