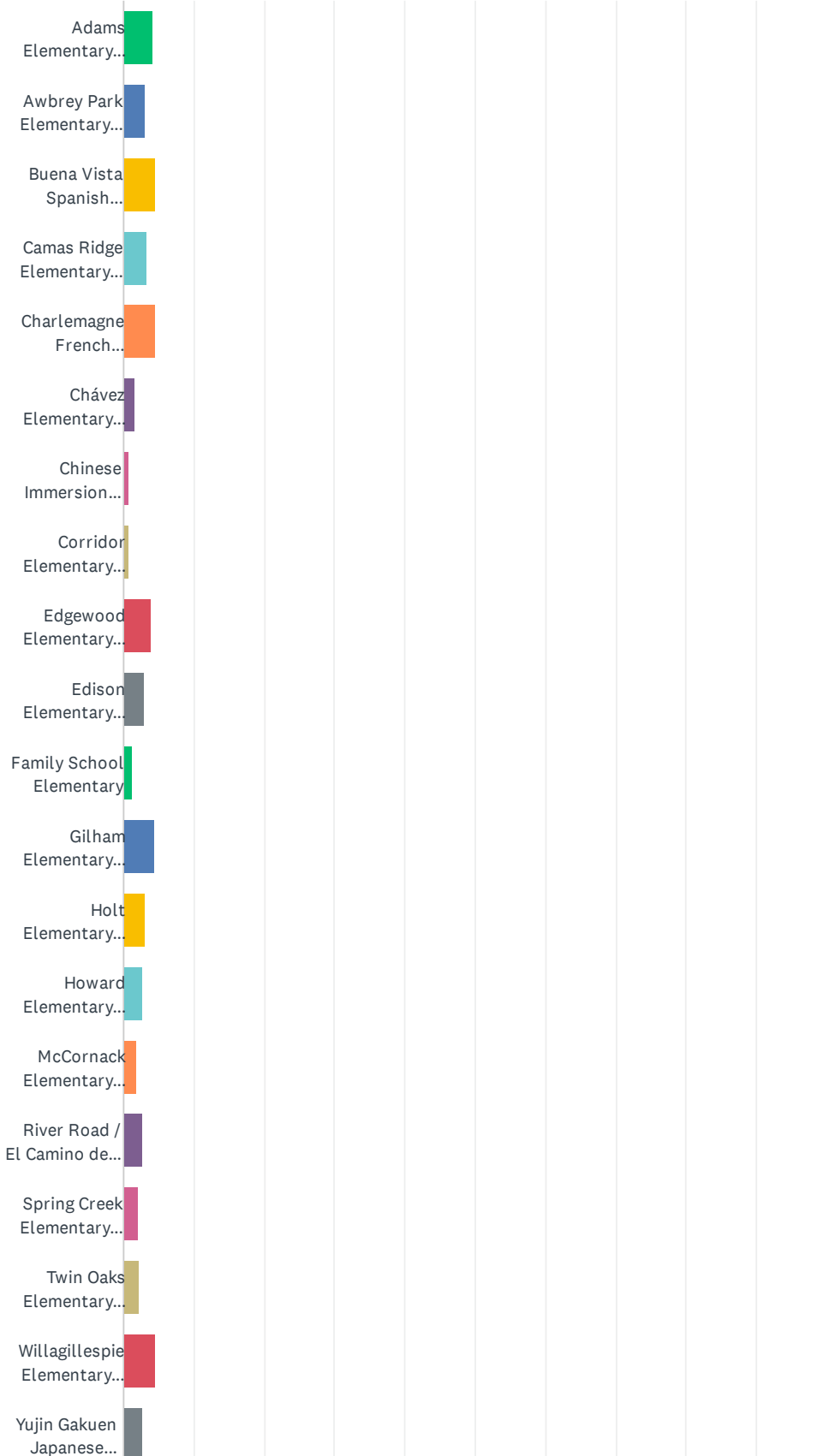

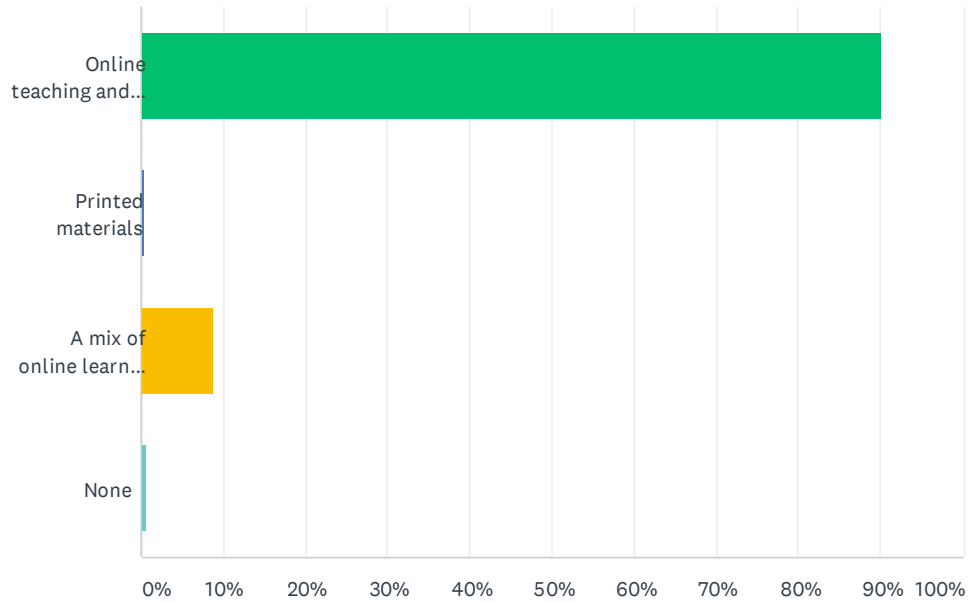

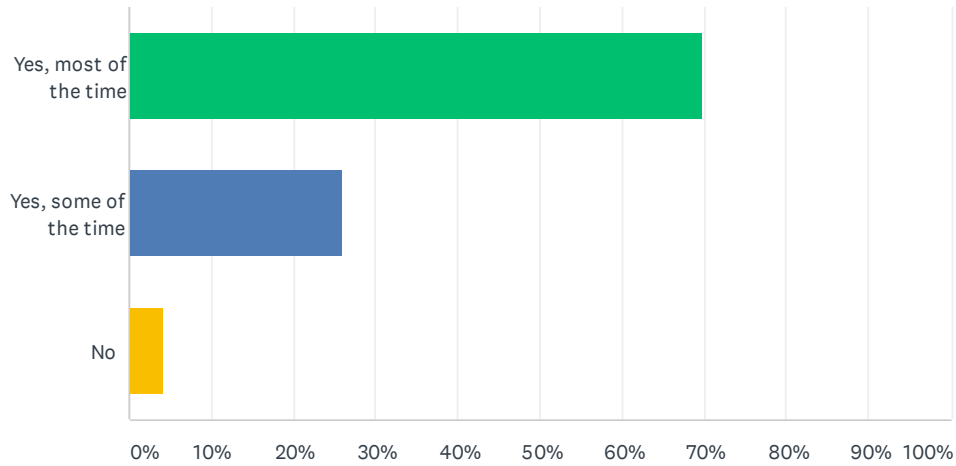

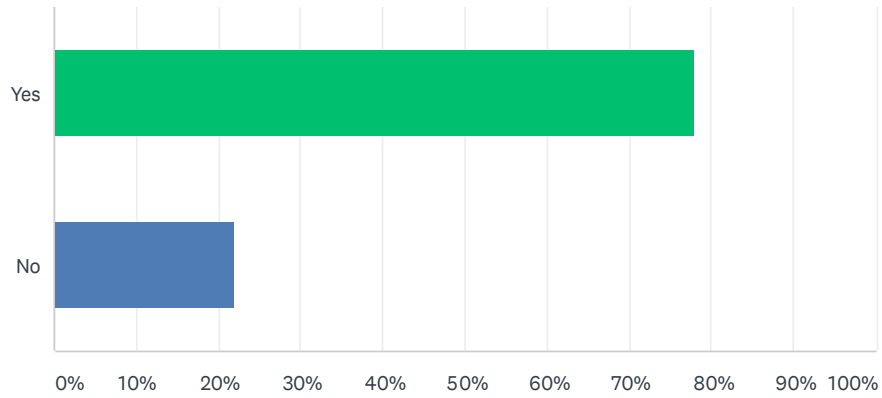

Q7 Did your school and/or teachers communicate to you and/or your students how much school work time was expected every day on average?

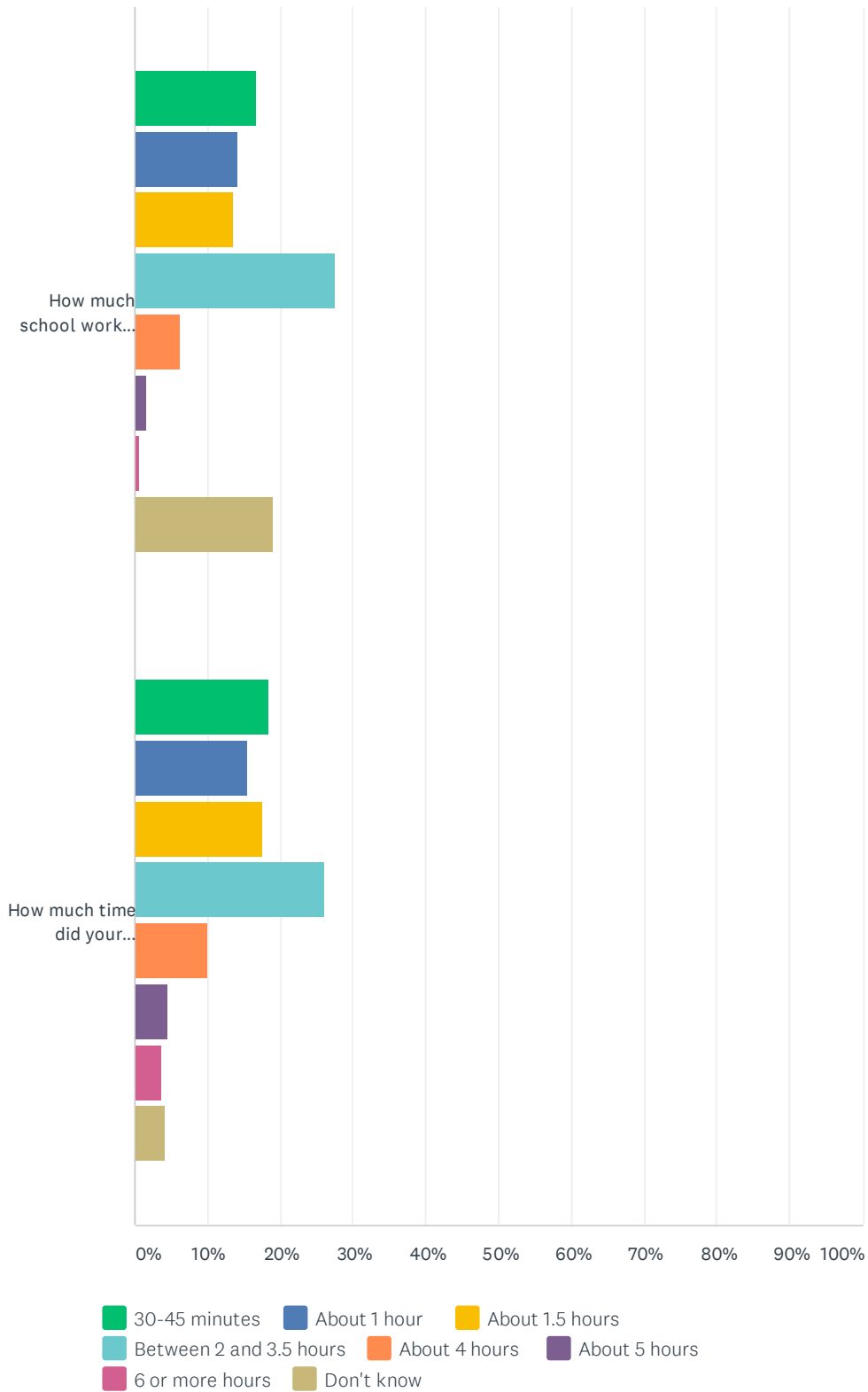

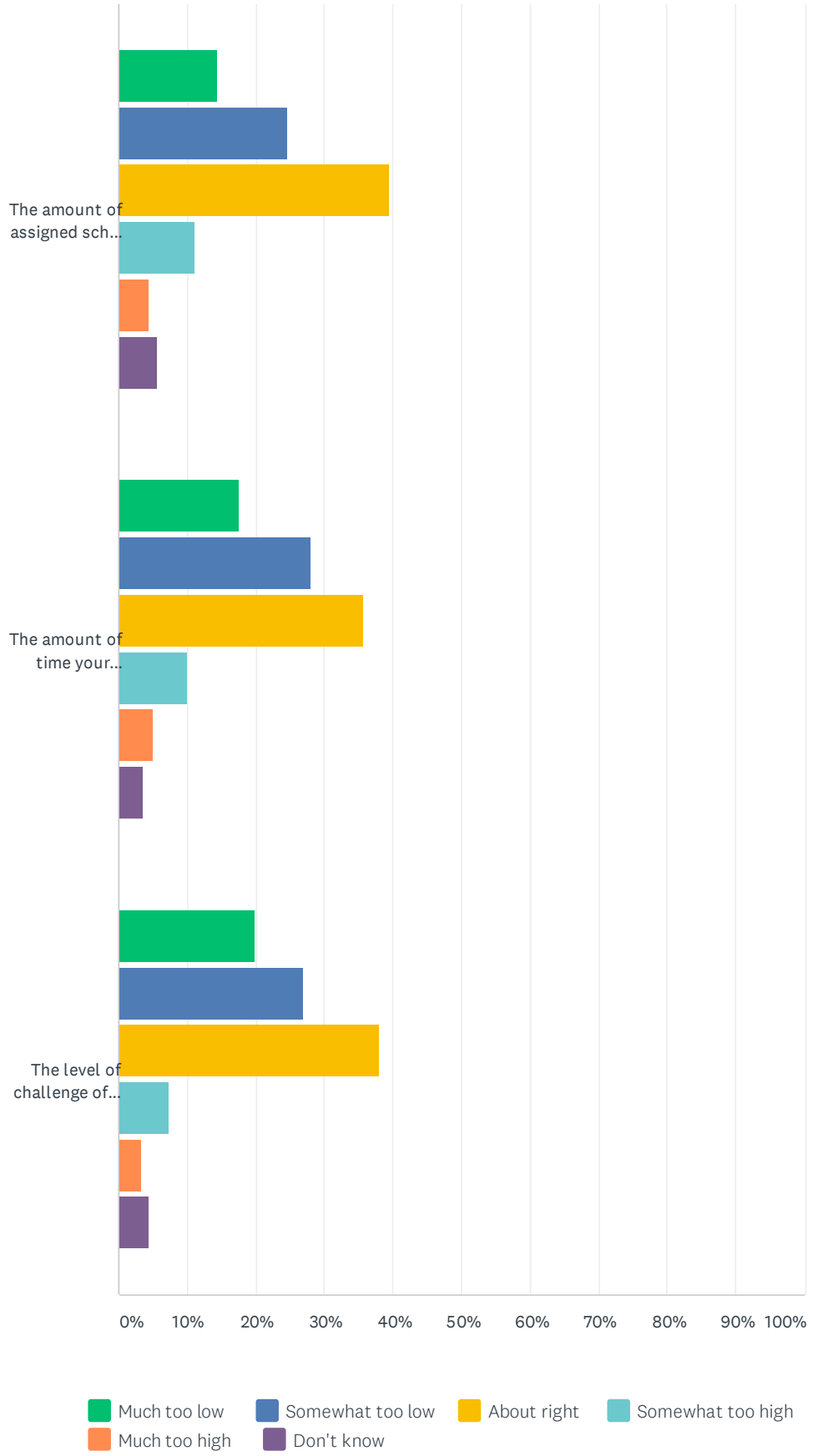

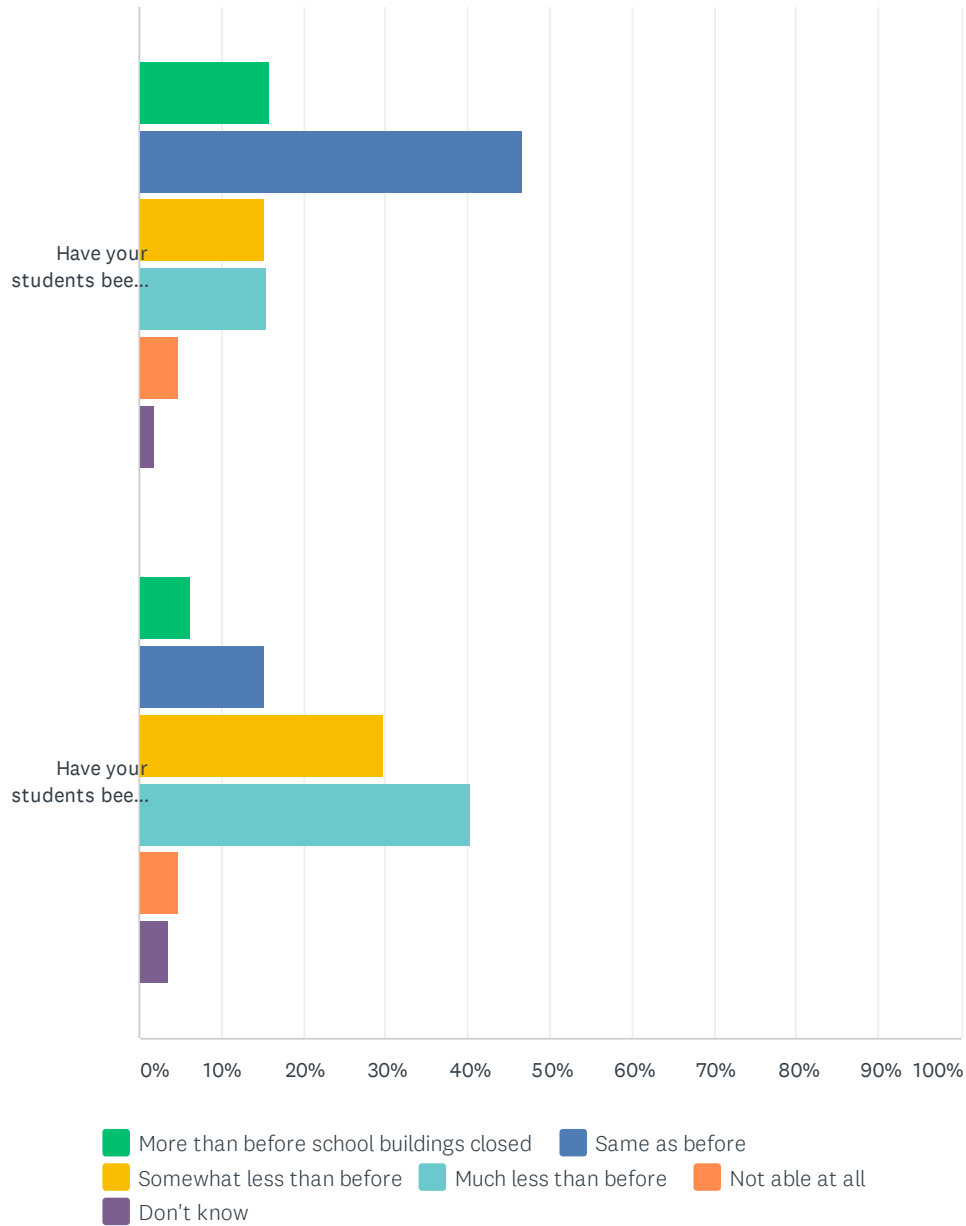

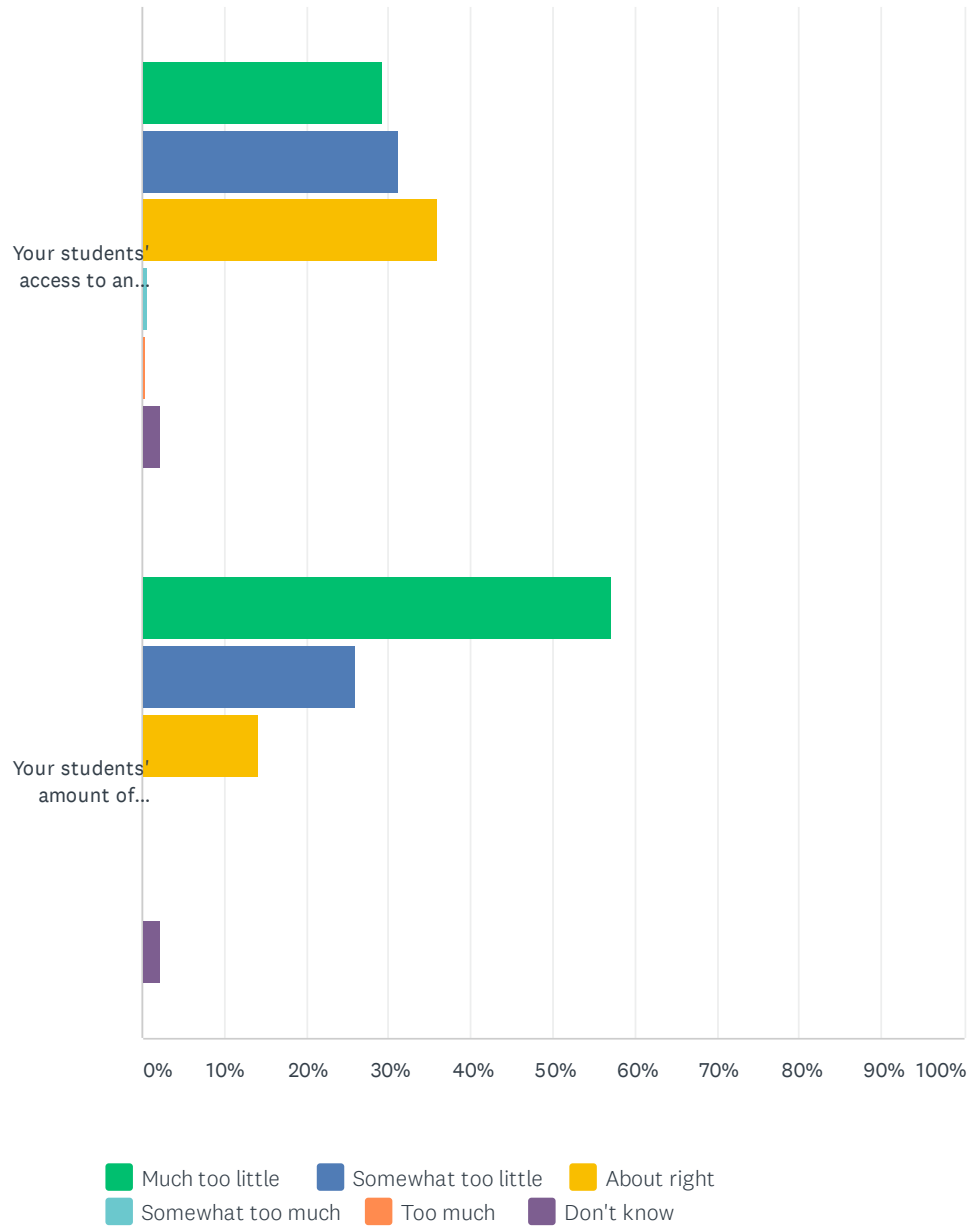

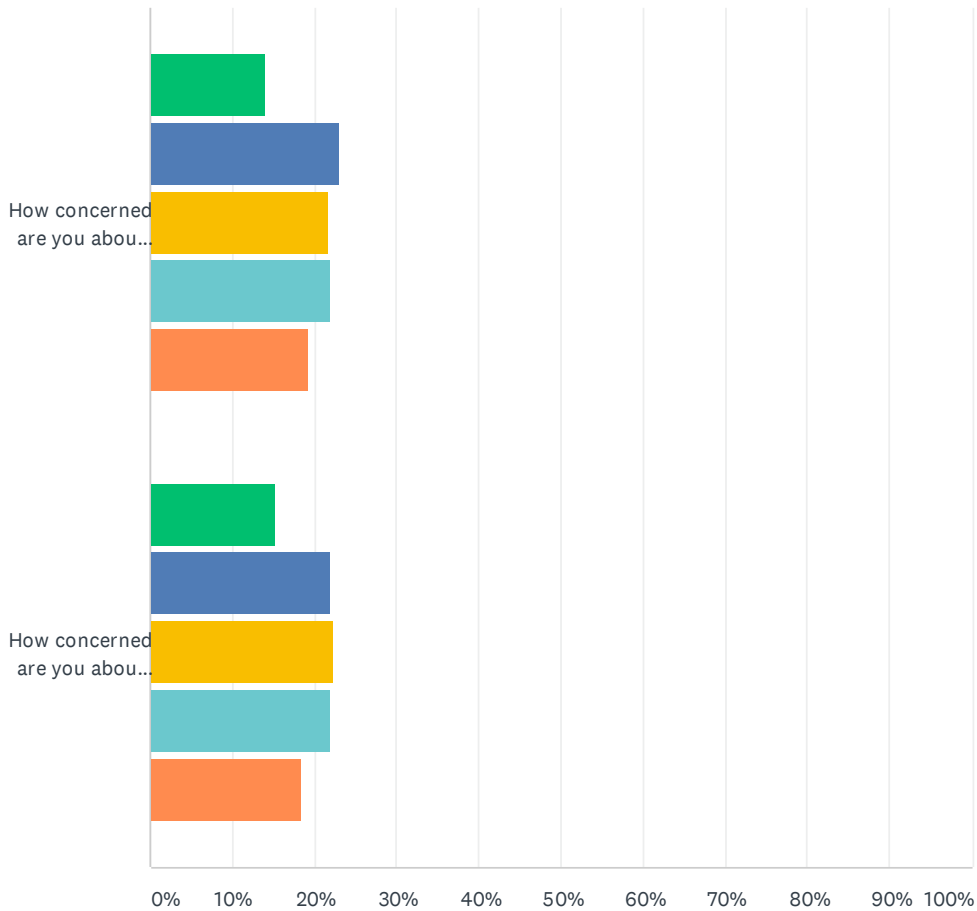

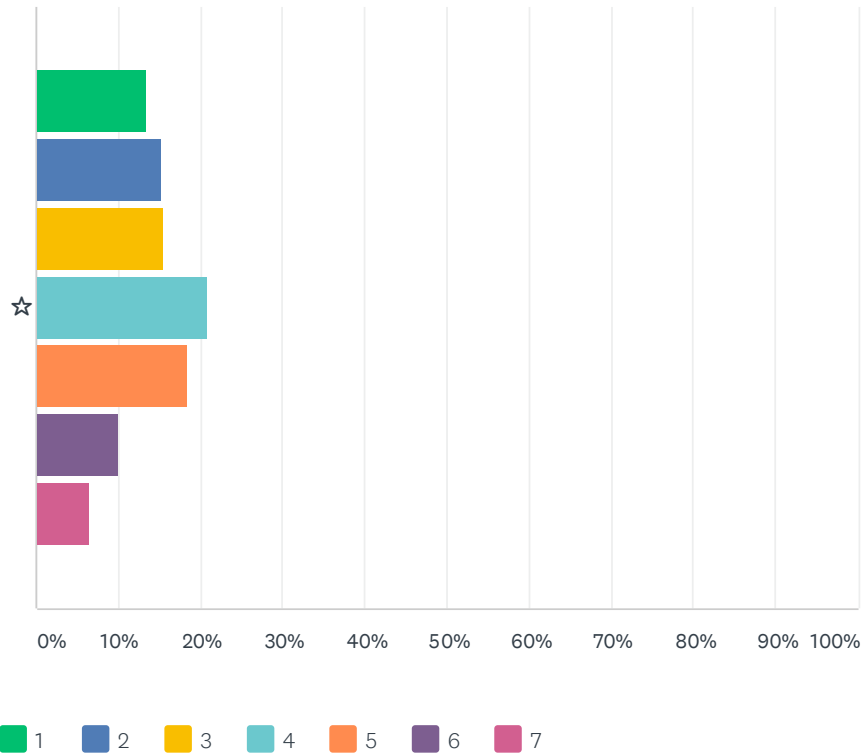

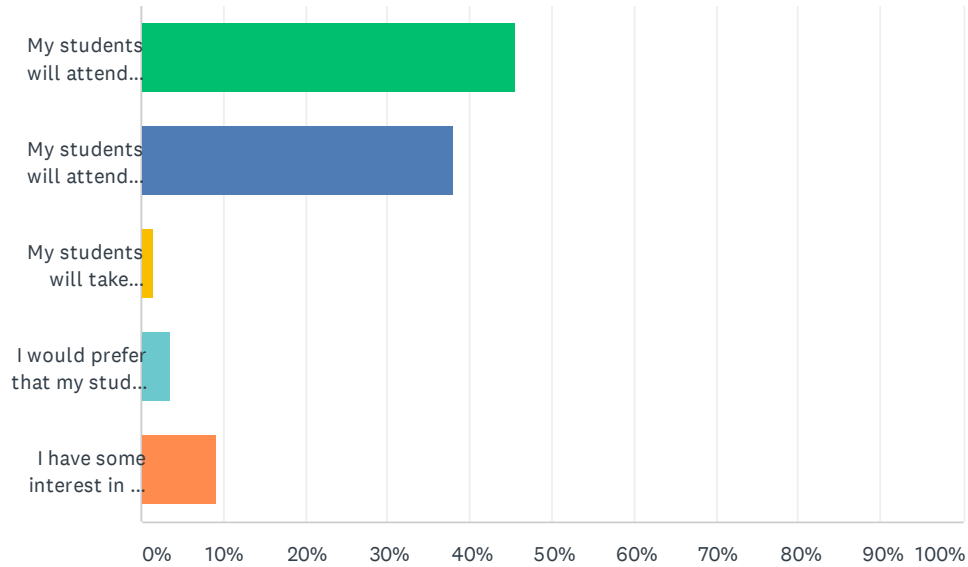

Q15 Will your students come to school on-site or will they continue school through the Eugene Online Academy, 4J's online school, for part or all of the school year?

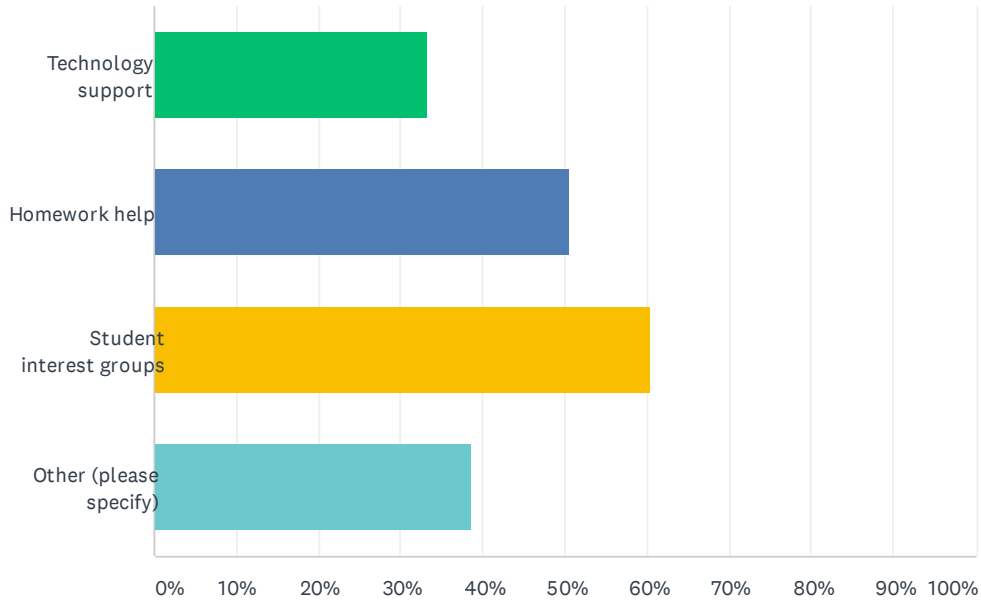

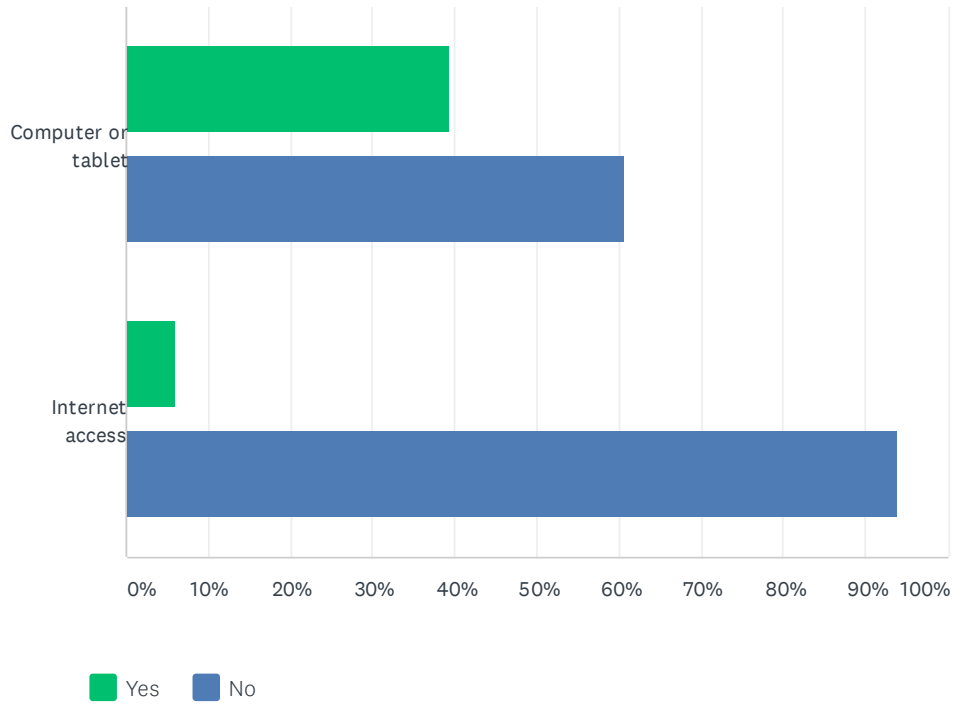

Q17 Would you need support from the district for a device and internet connection to access online teaching and learning?

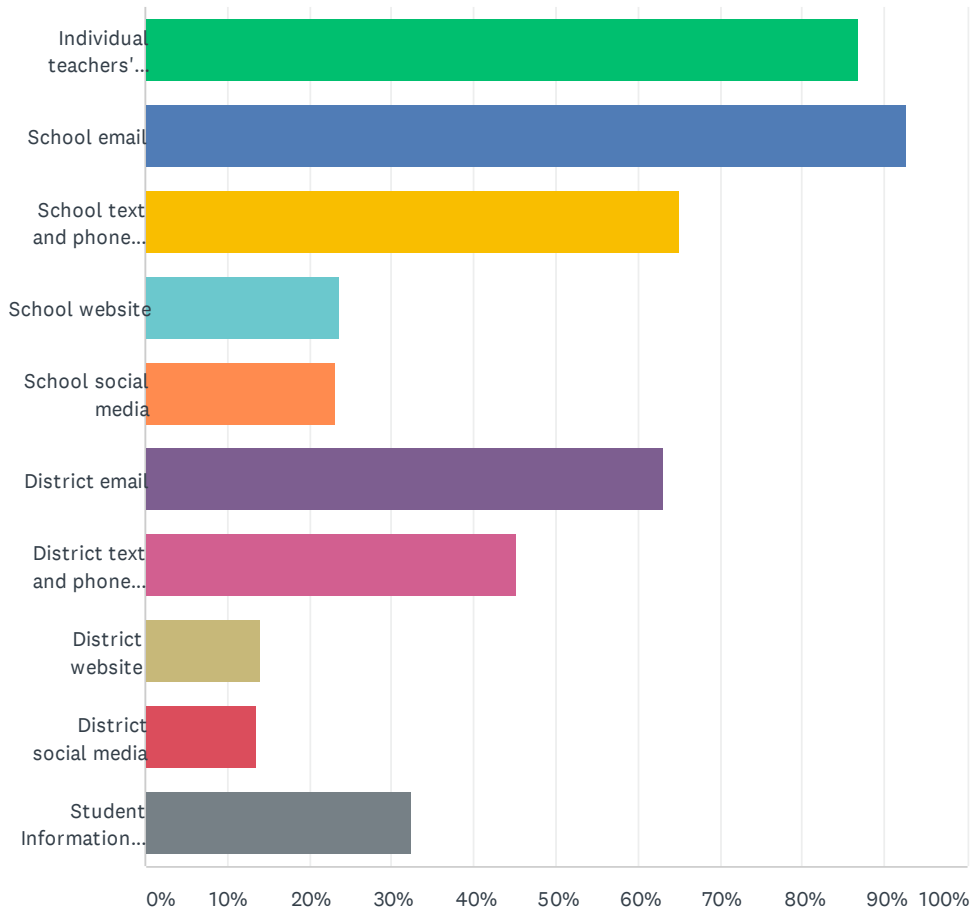

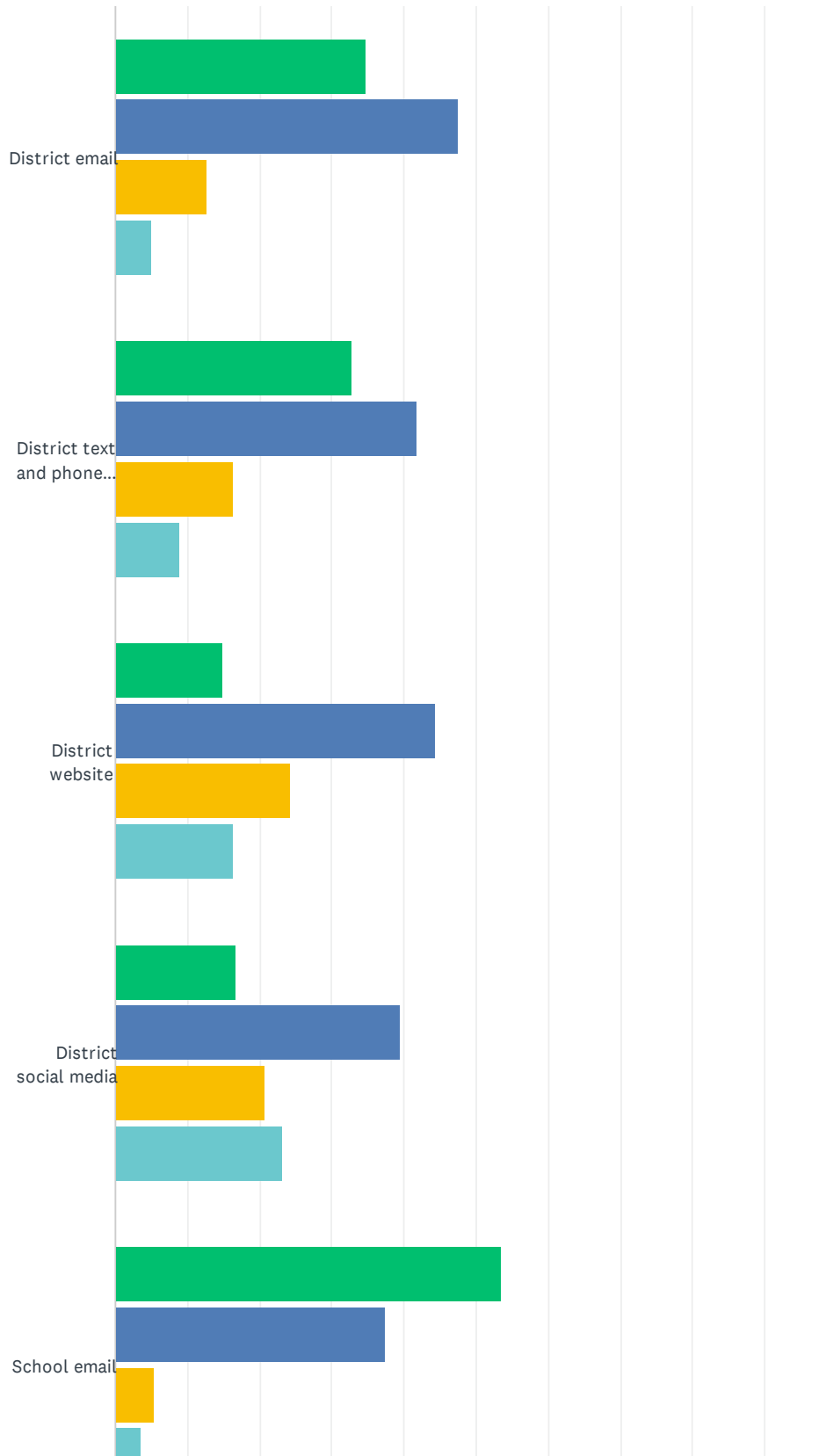

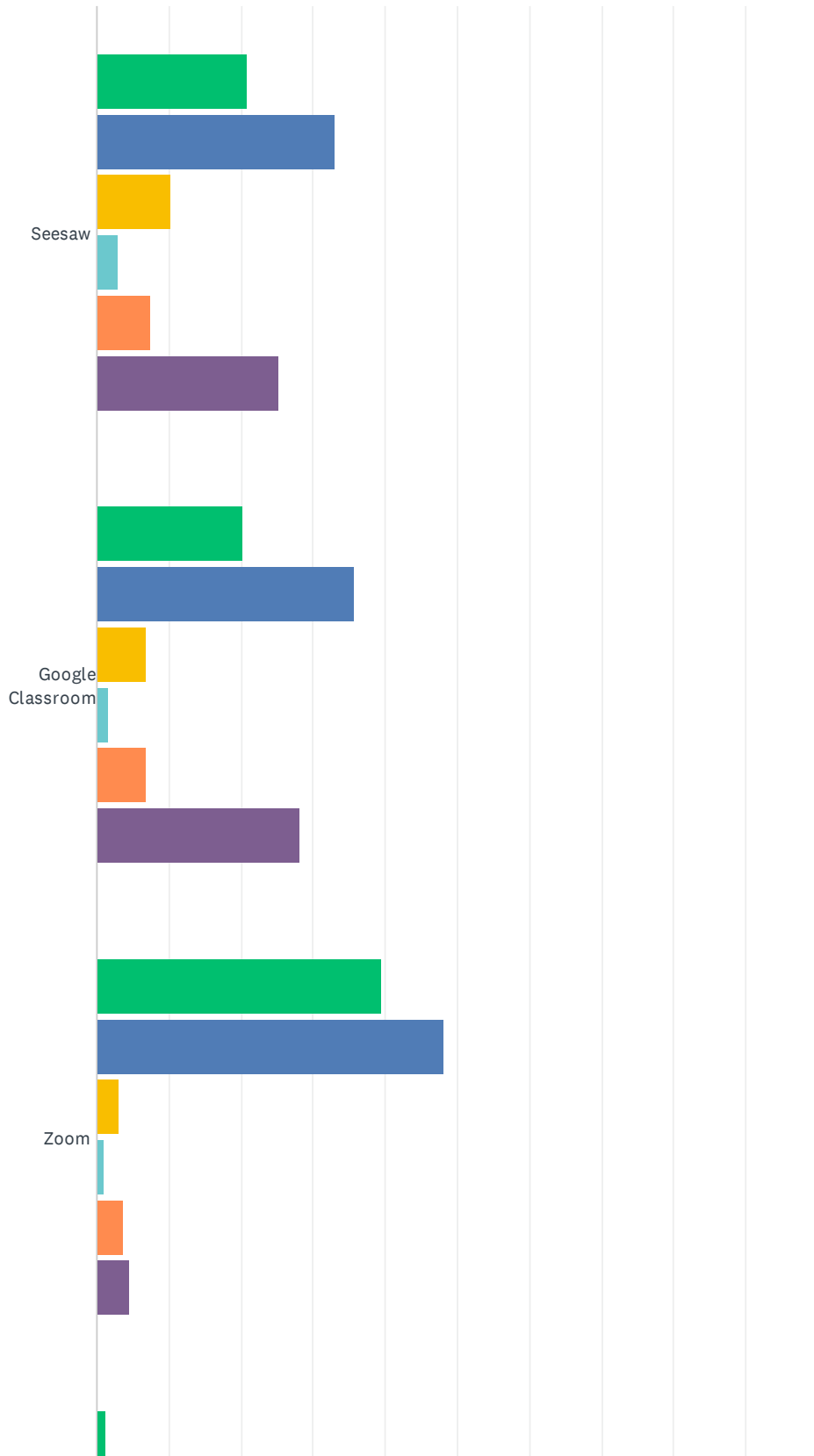

Q22 How easy to use were the software applications your students used for distance learning this spring?

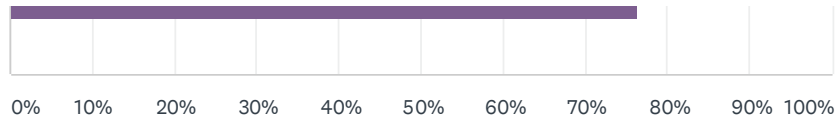

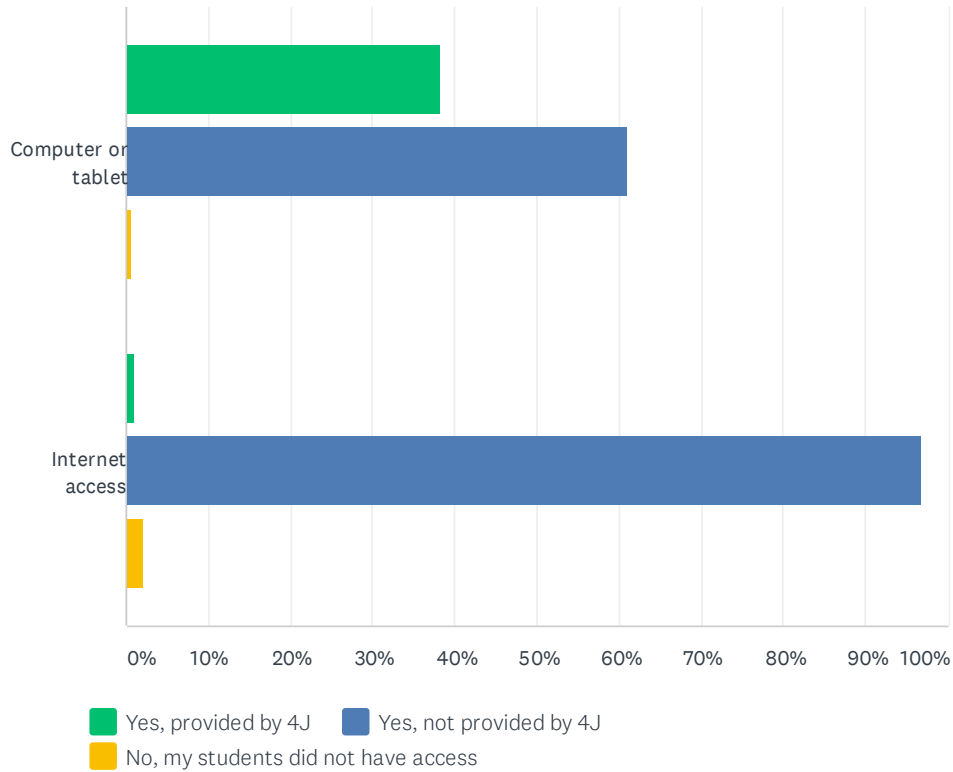

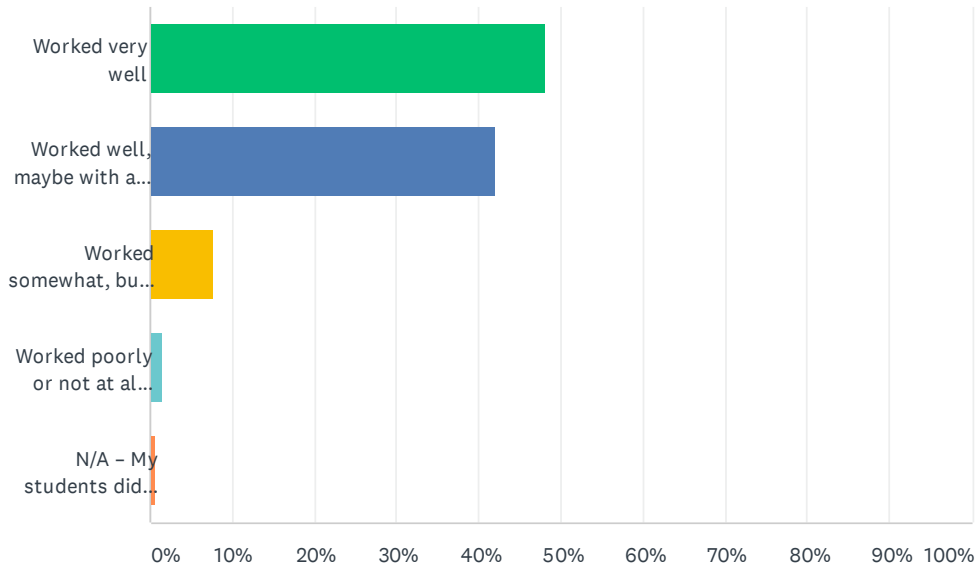

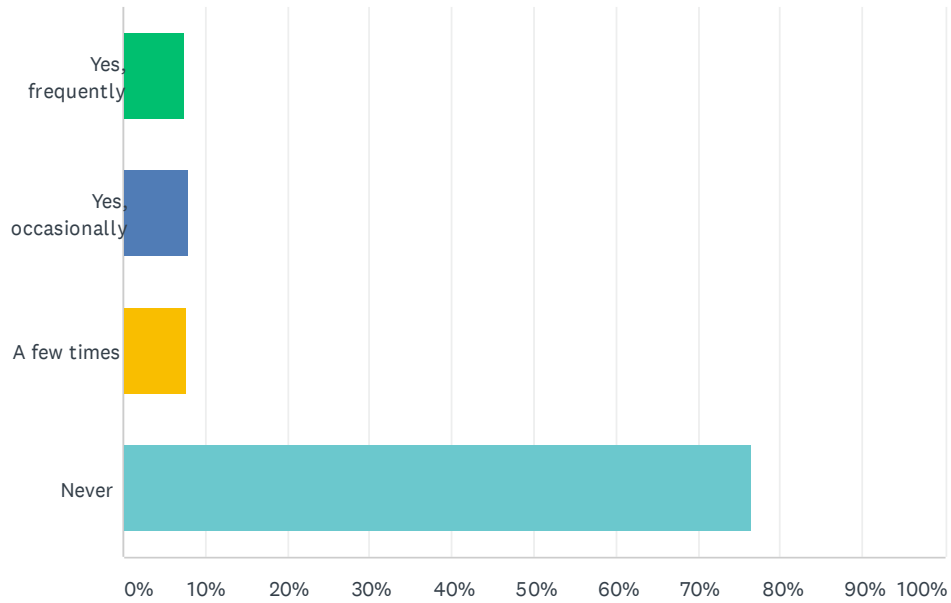

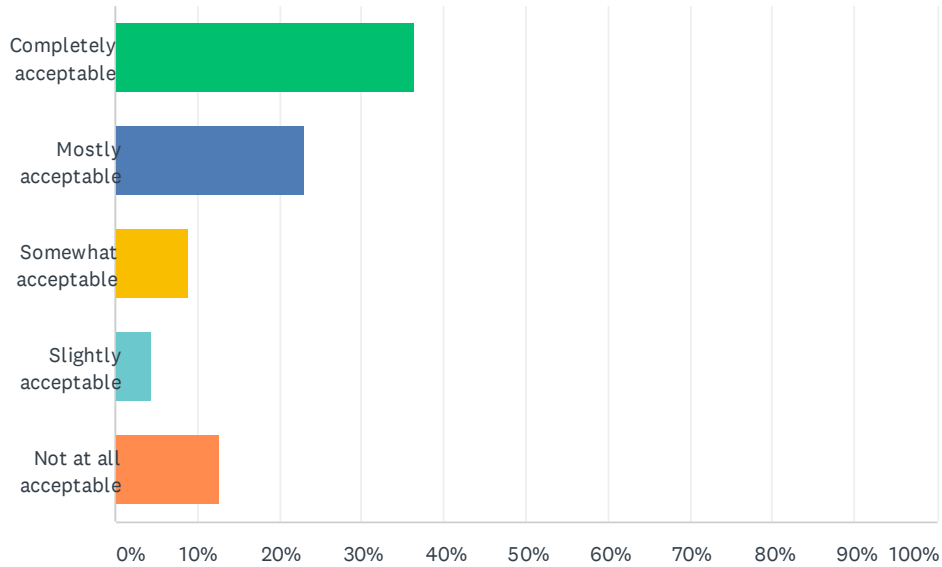

Q27 If your students have received free grab-and-go meals during the school building closure, generally, how acceptable have the emergency meals been as a replacement for regular school meals?

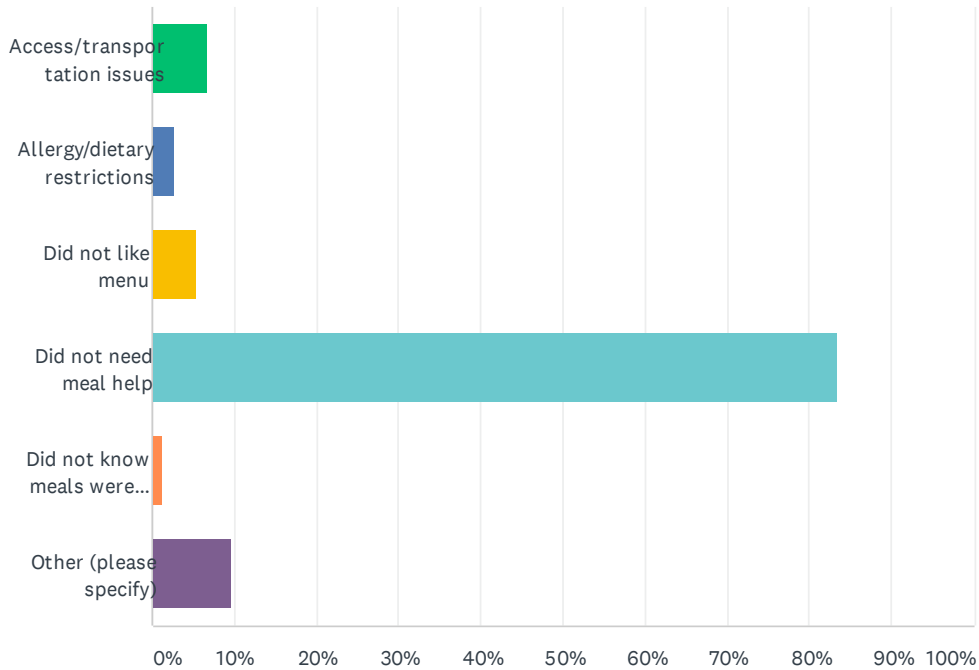

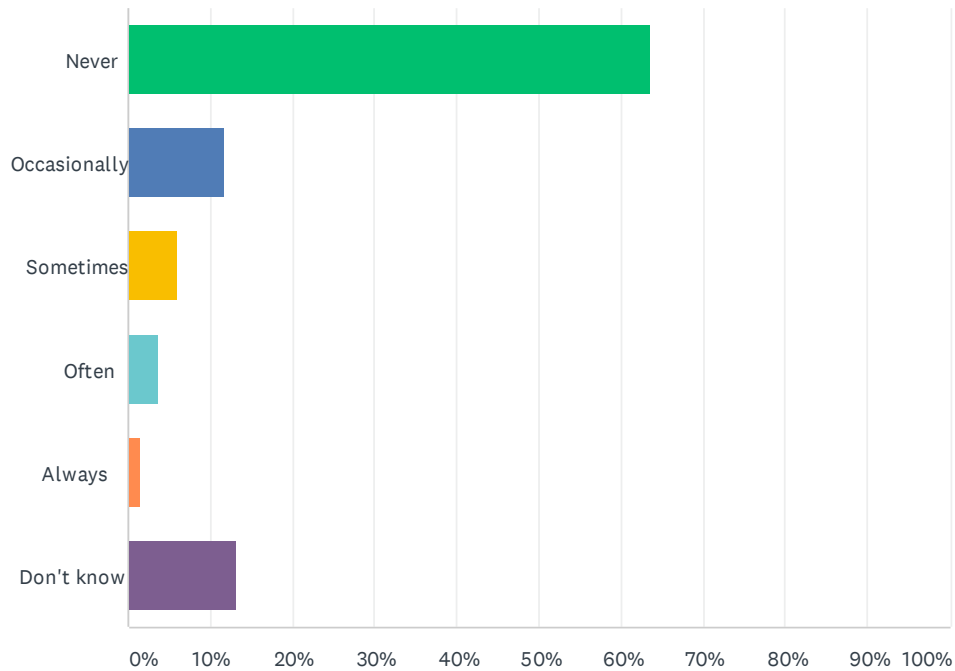

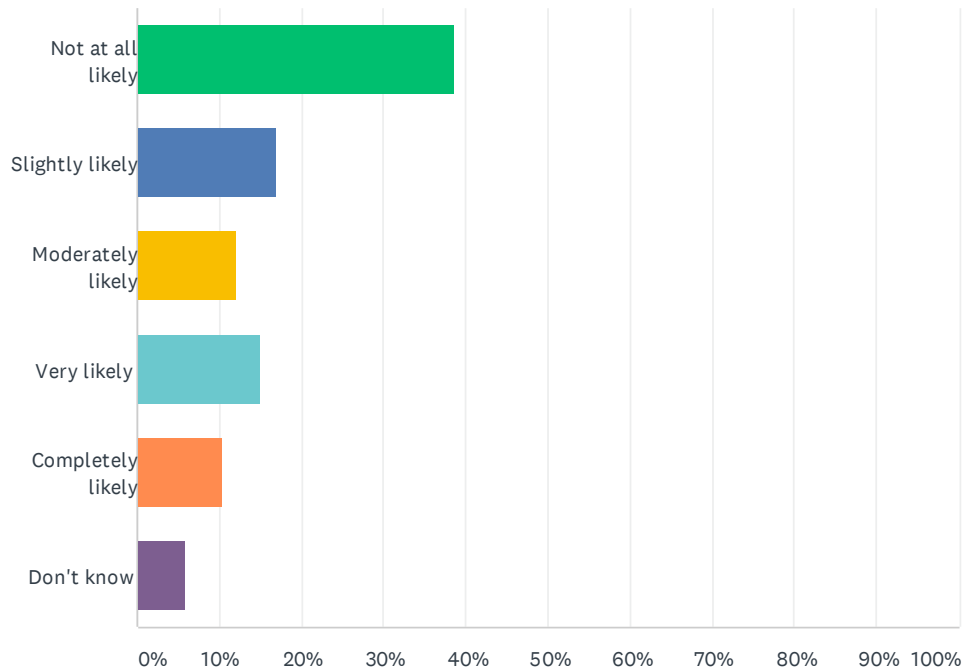

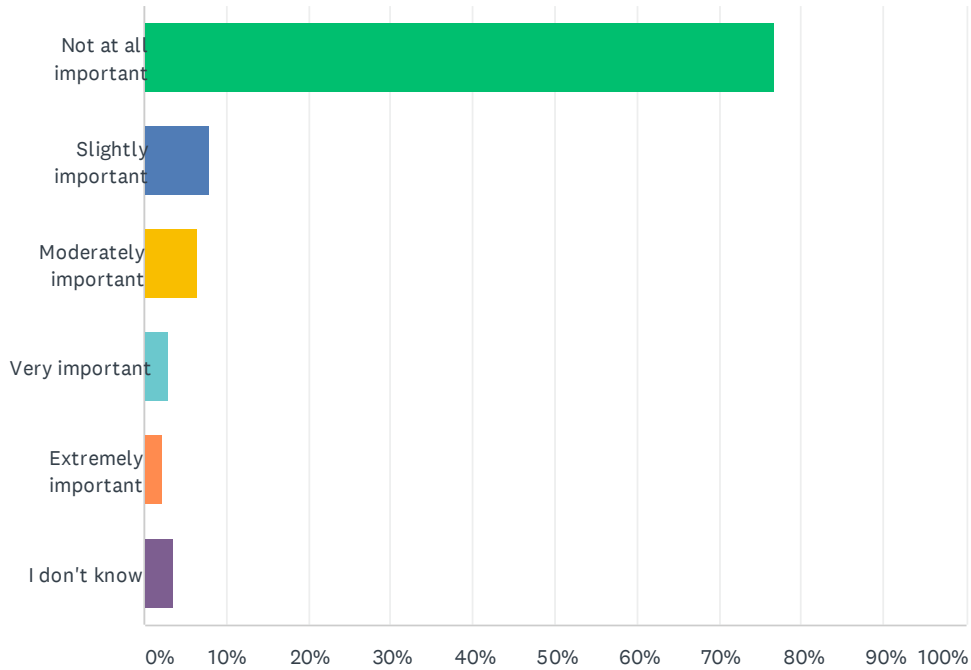

Q31 If there are days when your students are not learning on-site (e.g. distance learning at home), how important is it that they have access to school meals on these days?

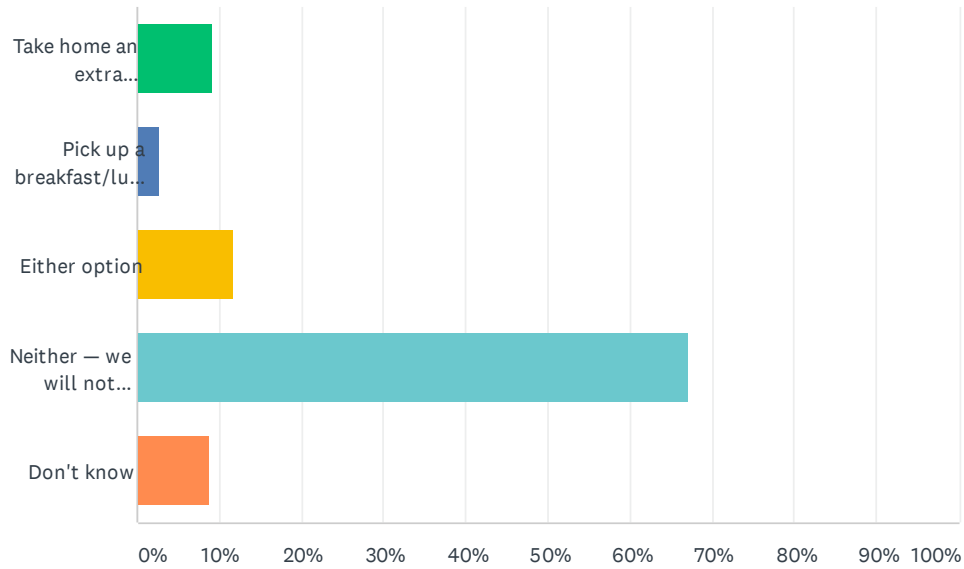

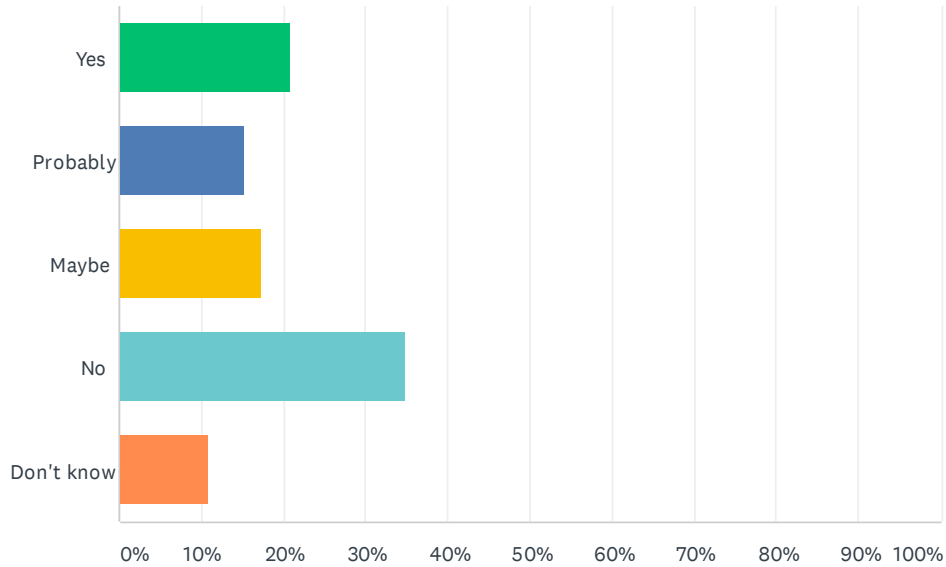

Q33 4J Nutrition Services provides access to menus with nutrition information and meal options online. Would you or your students use an online app to order school meals ahead of time?

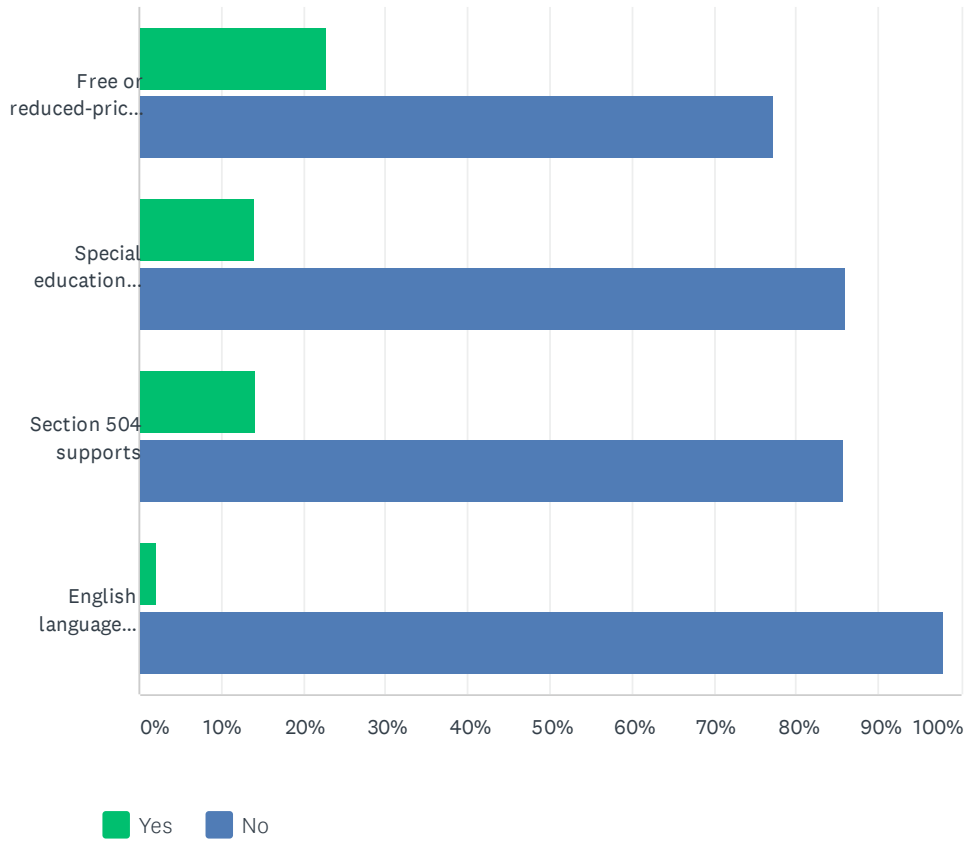

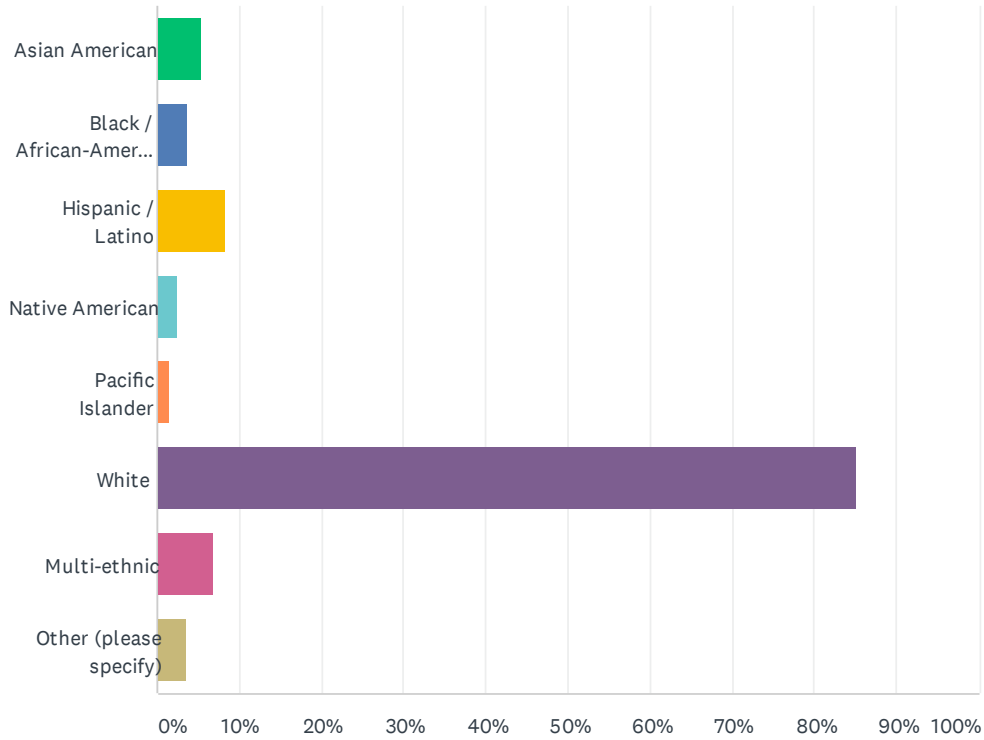

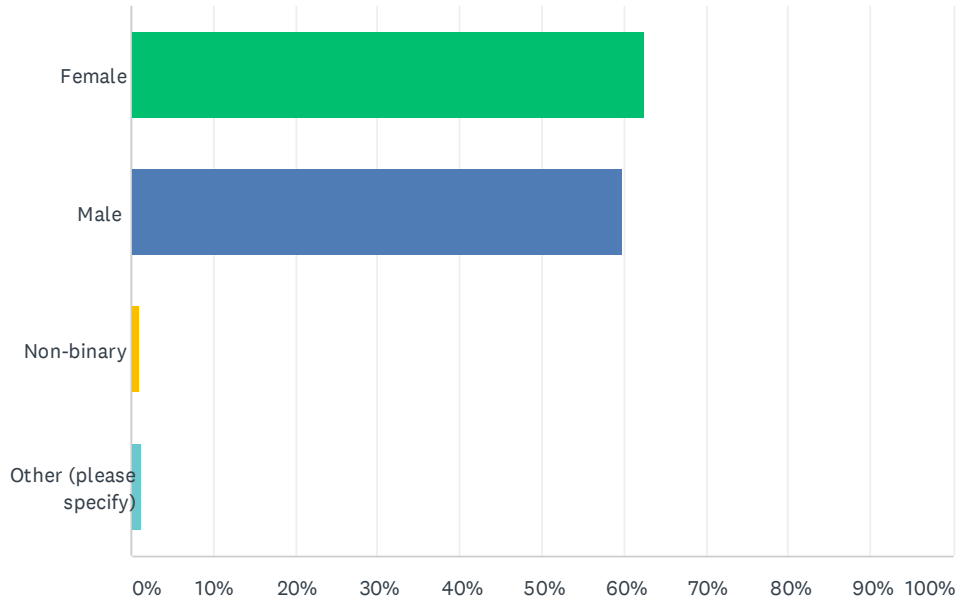
