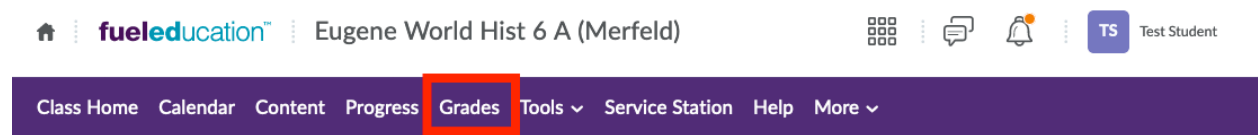


For Students: Checking Grades and Assignments in PEAK

Checking Assignments

1. Log in to Peak
2. Go into your course
3. Select grades on the purple bar:



4. The next screen shows a list of all of the assignments for the course. It is important to note that some of the assignments are worth more points than others.

Grades

1. Log in to Peak
2. Go into your course
3. Select Progress on the purple bar:
4. The progress screen shows a lot of information, but the most useful are the *Current Grade*, *Maximum Final*, and *Minimum Final* scores.



1. Current Grade= Just the grade of things you have done.
2. Maximum Final= The max grade you could receive if you finish all of the assignments.
3. Minimum Final= Your actual grade. Because EOA is asynchronous, you start with a 0% and then do assignments to build up to your final grade.

In the example below the student has done some assignments but has an average of 35.71% on what they have done (Current Grade). If they get 100% on the rest of the assignments, they can earn a 88.19% (Maximum Final). If they were to stop right now, their grade would be 6.56%. They need to do more assignments and tests in order to pass.
